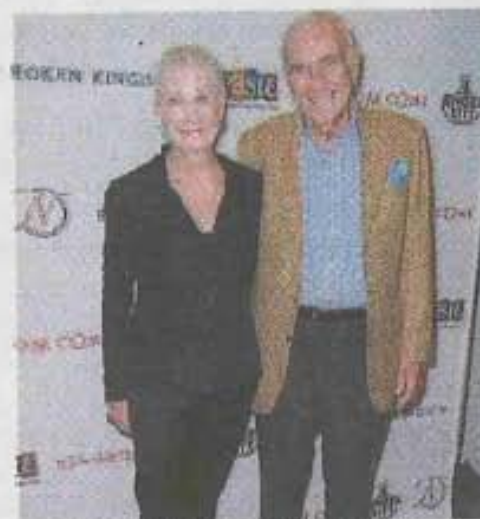
Every so often, a book comes along that touches peoples lives — "Pansy at the Palace: A Beverly Hills Mystery" by Cynthia Bardes is such a book.
